Mrs. Alice Tumber has been employed as Resident Director of the East Hampton Neighborhood Association (formerly known as the East Hampton Visiting Nurse Association) since October 1, 1968.

The Association owns and maintains a large two story building with an apartment on the second floor which is used by the resident director. In connection with the building there is a good-size playground and a lighted blacktopped basketball court.

The first floor of the building houses a large auditorium with a stage, and is equipped for indoor basketball; a good sized room that is used for meetings and morning pre-kindergarten groups under the supervision of the resident director and adult assistants; a large room used as a library with shelves of books, a divan, comfortable chairs, desk and TV; another room which is used as an office; and a large well-equipped modern kitchen.

The auditorium is used by Boy and Girl Scouts, for youth basketball- by civic organizations in the Town; some Church groups for meetings; and miscellanous private affairs. The first floor of the building is used by, and is available for use by, all organizations, Chusch groups, and individuals in the community.

All of this is under the supervision of the resident directors.
