TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

With regard to the enclosed form it would appear that it does not apply to our association.

The East Hampton Visiting Nurse Association was incorporated with the approval of the New York State Board of Charities on December 27, 1920, at which time there were no medical facilities within a reasonable distance from East Hampton.

The Association did have a visiting nurse and the small building at the rear of the Main Building was equipped and used for the isolation of diphtheria cases and later to perform tonsillectomies.

As time went on transportation was easier - both the town and county began providing visiting nurse services, and the East Hampton Medical Center came into being. This meant that the services the Association provided were no longer needed. The cottage was done over and made into living quarters and for several years was rented. Over ten years ago that cottage was sold and moved from the premises.

The Association has continued under the name under which it was originally incorporated but presently we are in the process of having the name changed to one which will be more applicable to the services we perform.

The East Hampton Visiting Nurse Association owns and maintains a large two-story wooden building known locally as the "Neighborhood House" - with an adjoining play area equipped with swings, seesaws, and a large lighted black-topped court. The building is used for pre-kindergarten groups under the supervision of the resident director and adult assistants. Occasional religious services are held in the building as well as meetings of Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Cub Scouts, and numerous other civic organizations. Youth basketball for both boys and girls is also scheduled. Sponsored parties for teenagers and organization dinners are also held in the building. The building is used by, and is available for use by, all organizations a church groups in the community.

The Association relies totally on contributions from organizations and the appeal letter which is sent out each year. The Department of Treasury - Internal Revenue Service - classifies the Association as a tax-exempt organization. Annual Reports are filed with Internal Revenue Service, State of New York Charitable Organizations Office of the Attorney General, and the New York State Board of Social Welfare.
