Thank you for your letter of September 16th.

I have prepared and am enclosing herewith Receipt and Release, in duplicate, to be executed by you as the Secretary and Treasurer of East Hampton Visiting Nurse Association.


As you undoubtedly know, 5 separate trusts were created under the Will of Mrs. Donoho. The Suffolk County National Bank of Riverhead is the Successor Trustee and has in its possession \$2,563.09 in the (a) trust, \$3,858.00 in the (b) trust, \$2,692.58 in the (c) trust, \$4,036.82 in the (d) trust and \$7,403.58 in the (e) trust.

Mary Hatch Stiles was the life beneficiary of the (a) and (c) trusts. She has passed away and The Suffolk County National Bank is ready to distribute the corpus of those two trusts to the remaindermen, namely, three-fourths to the Southampton Hospital Association and one-fourth to the East Hampton Settlement House. The Surrogate entered a decree on August 11th directing the Bank to pay out the corpus.

Please execute the Receipt and Release in duplicate and affix the corporate seal. Your signature should be acknowledged before a Notary Public. As soon as the duplicate instruments are returned to me, I will have the Bank forward its check to you in the sum of \$1313.92.

A third copy of the instrument is enclosed for your file.
