

THIS AGREEMENT, made the 1st day of November, 1956, by and between the EAST HAMPTON VISITING NURSE ASSOCIATION, a non-profit membership corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, having its office at East Hampton, Suffolk County, New York, party of the first part, and UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1 of the Town of East Hampton, Suffolk County, New York, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

That the party of the first part agrees to the use by the party of the second part of the basketball court and adjoining lavatories of the Neighborhood House, situate in the Town of East Hampton, Three Mile Harbor Road, from the 15th day of November, 1956, to the 1st day of March, 1957, on each day when school is in session for a period of not more than three hours between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 12:00 Noon upon the following conditions:

That the party of the second part shall pay the party of the first part a sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) as rental of the premises, said rental to be paid on or before the 1st day of May, 1957.
