Having come with the companie which first settled
Southampton in 1640.

Copied from the records of that church.

He was a Yorkshire man and coming over to New England
he became a member of the church at Boston, but was afterwards
thus employed towards the year 1640. The inhabitants of Lyn
straitened at home, looked out for a new plantation. So going
to Long Island they agreed with Lord Starling's agent and with
the Indian proprietors for a situation at the west end of the
Island, where the Dutch gave them such annoyance that they de-
serted their place for another at the east end of it. Proceeding
in the plantation by the accession of near one hundred families,
they called Mr. Pierson to go thither with them, who with seven
or eight more of their company regularly incorporated themselves
into the church state before going, the whole company also enter-
ing at the same time with the advice of the Governor of the
Massachusetts Bay into a civil combination for the maintaining
government among themselves. Thus was there settled a church at
Southampton under the pastoral care of that worthy man, where he
did with laudable diligence undergo two of the three hard labors-
teaching and governing - to make it become what Paradise was
called - (The island of the Innocent) It was afterwards found
necessary for this church to be divided. Upon which occasion
Mr. Pierson, referring his case to council, his removal was
directed into Brainford, over upon the main, and Mr. Fordham
came to serve and feed that part of the flock which was left at
Southampton - but wherever he came he shone -

He left behind the character of a pious prudent man and a true child of Abraham, now safely lodged in Abraham's bosom.

The last Will and Testament of William Ludlam Senior. I commend my soul to God and my estate I bestow as followeth:

Inprimis, my Will is that my son William shall have a cow. 2. I do give unto my Daughter Grace one Cow. 3. I do give unto my Daughter Mary one Cow. 4. I do give unto my daughter ffrancis one Cow. 5. I do give unto my sonn Anthony all my Housing and Land at the old Ground and ffifty Pound commonage to him and his heirs forevere Provided that my sonn Henry shall have a third part of ye said land for the Terme of seven years after date hereof. 6. I do give unto my Sonn Joseph my now dwelling House with two acres of land adjoining to the Mill and Mill Pond, on the east side of the Mill with ffifty pound Commonage to him and his Heirs forever. 7. I do give unto ye oldest child of my Sonn William fifty shillings, and to my Sonn Henry's child fifty shillings and my Daughter Grace's Child fifty shillings. And unto my Daughter Mary's Eldest Childe fifty shillings and my Daughter ffrancis eldest Child fifty shillings. 8. That whereast there is a covenant made between me and Sam Davis the said Samuel Davis is to enjoy the cows and the benefit of the House and Land specified in the said Covenant from the date hereof until the fourth of March next ensuing. 9thly and Lastly I do will that my Sonn Henry bee my Executor and to pay or cause to bee paid all my Debt, and also all the above mentioned Legacyes and also to build up the Mill that now is sufficiently vizt halfe at his own proper charge and the other half out of my estate and my Sonn Henry to have half of the said Mill to him and his heirs forever and my Sonn Joseph the other half to him and his heirs forever. Also I give unto my Sonn Henry ffifty Pounds commonage with and belonging to the Land here hath now in possession as it standeth on Record. Also I do give unto him the said Henry Thirty Six Acres of land lying and being at the Mill Pond head with all my household Goods Cattle a Cattles whatsoever to him and his heirs forever. Witnesse my hand the day and year above written.

William Ludlam was one of the first settlers in Southampton and is first mentioned in 1656 though there is reason to believe he was here two or three years previous. He owned the water mill and acted as miller until the time of his death. His son Anthony lived at Mecox, on the farm still in the family and owned by his descendant, Charles Ludlow. His son Joseph moved to Oyster Bay as early as 1672 - having sold his share of the mill to his brother Henry - and some of his descendants are still living at the west end of the Island. Some of the family were among the colony who went from this place and settled Cape May in 1691. While the

descendants in other places have retained the original name "Ludlam", the families in this town have changed it to "Ludlow". This is said to have been the work of the notorious Stephen Burroughs an adventurer from New England, who taught school in Bridgehampton about 1795. The will is recorded in the New York Surrogates office in liber 1, page 1.

WILL OF THOMAS SAYRE -

1597 - 1670

In the name of God Amen, I Thomas Sayre Of Southampton on Long Island in the Yorke being in perfect strength of mind blessed be ye Lord for it, but weake of body not knowing ye day of my appointed change doe make this last will and Testament in manner following:-

Imprimis:- I give and freely bequeath my Soule unto God who gave it and my body unto earth from whence it ~~came~~ was first taken.

2nd:- I give unto my sonne Ffrancis Sayre two acres of land lying next unto his own in Capt. Neck in ye Great Playnes and two acres more of land lying in ye eight acres lott in ye said Great Playnes - a pewter flagon, a pewter bowl and great pewter platter.

I give unto my sonne Daniel Sayre two acres of land lying next unto ye above ye said two acres in ye said eight acre lotts, and three acres more of land lying in the Ten Acre lotts and one great pewter platter.

3rd:- I give unto my sonne Daniel Sayre two acres of land lying next unto ye above said two acres in ye said Eight acre lotts and three acres more of land lying in the Ten Acre Lotts and one great pewter platter.

4th:- I give unto my sonne Joseph Sayre fforty pounds sterling to be paid him by my executor ten pounds per annum to begin with in five years next after my decease, to be paid in good merchants shoes or other pay that will procure Hides toward his setting up as a Tanner.

5th:- I give unto my daughter Damaris fforty shillings.

6th:- I give unto my daughter Mary Price fforty shillings.

7th:- I give unto my daughter Hannah Sayre twenty pounds to be paid at her day of marriage or when she shall be eighteen years of age which shall first happen and that my executor doe keep her cow and calf and their for her until she she shall be married or in some other capable way to maintain them.

8th:- I give my household goods to be equally divided between my sons Job and Joseph and Hannah and that when they be divided Hannah have her first choice of ye partes.

9th:- Lastly, I by this last will and Testament have made my

son, Job Sayre my sole Executor to receive all my Worldly estate both of Housing, Lands, goods and cattle and debts due to me from any person or persons and to pay all debts due from me and all Legacies specified.

WILL OF THOMAS HALSEY

DRAWN IN JUNE, 1677.

Southampton in Yorkshire, ye 28th day of June, 1677.

The last will and testament of Thomas Halsey, Sr., being in a right mind and sound judgeis as followeth:

Imprimis. I give and bequeath my soule to God that gave it and my body I bequeath to the earth, decently to be buried, and my worldly goods as followeth:

2ndly. I doe give unto my wife one woollen wheel, and one linnen wheel and my Little Iron pott and a yellow rugg, and one white duck blanket, and foure bushels of wheat, to bee paid yearly as long as shee liveth, the first to be paid within one month and four score sheep.

3rdly. I do give and bequeath unto my son Thomas, my house and housing and home lot with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and ye Beach lot and the little plain close on the south side of Mr. Rainer's, commonly called Troublesome, and the close at ye Mill Neck, commonly known by the name of Peter's close. And I do give to my son Thomas the lot that I had in this last Division at Meacock's, and the table in the parlor, and the five joint stools, and the bedstead and curtains in the porch chamber.

4thly. I do give and bequeath unto my son Isaac my close at the head of the creek, and five acres adjoining thereto, and five acres in the Great Plain in the Ten-acre lots, and three acres lying at the Town Pond, and ten acres in the ox pasture. And I do give unto my son Isaac the lying lot, with four acres and a half in the Little Plain. And I do give unto my son Isaac of the next Division twenty acres, and he is to have his choice out of my three hundred pounds right. in lue of the land at Sagaponack, and the remainder of all Divisions whatsoever hereafter they are to divide it equally between them all three. And the rest of the Division he is to have his equal part with Thomas and Daniel. And Hog Neck is to be divided betwixt them equally. Also I do give unto my son Isaac that lot of meadow that is Sebonack on the south side, and one acre in Halsey's Neck, and half the meadow on the South Beach, and the other half to Daniel.

6thly. I do give and bequeath unto my son Daniel one lot of meadow lying on the north side of Sebonack, and the home lot that I bought of Mr. Smith and my lot at Sagaponack and two acres in the Little Plain that is the eastern most two acres that I have there. And I do give Daniel one horse, one mare and two oxen.

7thly. I do give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth the wife of Richard Howell, twenty pounds, to be paid ingoods or cattle according as two men shall pries them.

8thly. I do order that my three sons shall divide all Quanquanantuck and all the north side towards Southold and all Hog Neck betwixt them equally. I do will and appoynt my sons Thomas and Isaac to be executors of this my last will and testament, to see that it be justly and thoroughly performed. And what shall remain of the estate not here mentioned in my will, that they divide it equally between them my two executors.

NOTE:- The home lot left to his son Isaac is the house and lot lately owned by Thomas Nicoll White, and now by Mr. Peabody, known as "The Hollyhocks", built in 1660. The beach lot was 18 acres and is at the foot of First Neck Lane, called the Fithian Lot. The close at Head of Creek was 15 acres, part of the late Jehiel Sayre farm, until recently owned by J. Bowers Lee. The three acre lot by the Town Pond is now the homestead of Henry Culver, Public Service Property during the war, and land adjoining. The close at (Water Mill) Mill Neck is part of Theodore A. Halsey's. The home lot "bought of Mr. Smith" is at the foot of Main Street, Southampton, the elegant mansion of Mr. Henry A. Robbins stands upon it. The farm at Wickapogue which was owned by his son, Daniel Halsey, and now by his descendents was given to him by his father before his death. Daniel Halsey married Jemima Woodhull, daughter of Richard Woodhull.

It is interesting to note that as early as 1677 Mecox, Sagoonack, Hog Neck, Sebonack, Town Pond, Halsey's Neck Ox Pasture, Little Plain and Great Plain, were established names. Quaquanantuck is East Quogue, and Mill Neck soon after became Water Mill.

Thomas Halsey was one of the thirteen "undertakers" of the Southampton Colony. When the company was made up in Lynn, Massachusetts, and he was one of the first to settle here. The earliest record of a death in the colony is that of his wife, Phebe, who was murdered by a Pequot Indian in 1649. The earliest marriage on record is that of Thomas Halsey to the widow, Ann Johns, in 1660.

WILL OF RICHARD CLARKE - 1697.

In the name of God Amen, I Richard Clerke of Elizabeth Towne in East Jersey being verry sick & weake but of perfect Memory do make & ordaine this to bee my last Will & Testament in manner and forme following,

First I give & bequeath my precious Soule to God which gave it, And my body to the Earth to bee buried in a decent manner.

Secondly I give & bequeath to my deare & loveing wife Elizabeth Clerke all & singular my moveable estate for her to dispose of as shee shall think fitt.

Thirdly I give & bequeath to my Eldest Sone Richard Clerke the Towne Lott of land adjoyning to the Dwelling house he now lives in containing Eight Acres more or less, he paying in consideration thereof to my Sone John Clerke the sume of five pounds currant monie to bee payd by my Sone Richard or his Assignes after my decease within two months - Next I give & bequeath to my sayd Sone Richard Clarke the one halfe of a parcel of land lyeing seittuate & adjoyning to the wood lands of John Little the whole containg twenty acres more or less, - Next I give & bequeath to my seaven sones (vis) Richard Clarke, John Clarke, Jusua Clarke, Samuell Clarke, Ephraime Clarke, Thomas Clarke & Benjamin Clarke, All & singular a parcell of lands containing one hundred fifty two acres more or less, bounded East by John Toe, South by James Haines, South East by Charles Tucker, and the other parts to land unsurveyed to bee equally devided amongst my seaven sones aforesayd share & share alike.

Item I give & bequeath to my Sone Richard Clarke six acres of meadow land lyeing in the Towne Creeke as Also six acres more in the great meadow.

Item I also give & confirme to my sone John Clarke the sayd parcell of land for which I have given him Deede of gift, Also two acres of meadow lyeing in Stoffills Creeke,

Item I give & bequeath to my Sones Josua & Ephraime Clarke the Lott of land formerly called or knownen by the Name of Aaron Lott on which Josuas house now stands to bee devided equally betweene them both, Josua having his half on that side the Lott on which his house now stands.

Item I give & bequeath to my foure Sones (vis) Joshua Clarke, Ephraime Clarke, Thomas Clarke & Benjamin Clarke a certaine parcell of land comonly called or knownen by the name of the blind Ridge containing Eightie five Acres more or less, to bee equally devided amongst my sayd foure sones share & share alike.

Item I give & bequeath to my Sones Thomas Clarke & Benjamin Clarke a certaine pice of meadow land on Woodroffs Creeke adjoyning to Henry Norris land to bee equally devided amongst them both.

WILL OF RICHARD CLARKE - 1697.

Item I give & bequeath to my Sones Joshua Clarke & Samuell Clarke a certaine peece of meadow land lyeing on the South side of Coll: Townelies Meadow, as also foure acres of meadow land lyeing in Stoffils Creeke to bee equally devided amongst them both.

Item I give & bequeath to my Sone Ephraime Clarke two acres of meadow lyeing in the sayd Creeke.

Item I give & bequeath to my Sone Thomas Clerke a certaine Lott of land Commonly knoen or called by the Name of Curwithee Lott as alos part of the Lott of land called Rodger Lott, beginning at the upper End joyning to George Ross & to End at the corner of the Lott on which my dwelling house now stands. I also give to my sone Thomas a certaine peece of meadow land lyeing on Raway meadow by the great River.

Item I give & bequeath to my Sone Benjamin Clerke the Dwelling house with the barne orchard stables etc, in which I now live as also the ground thereunto belonging Commonly called or knoen by the name of Grays poynt, as also the other part of Rodger Lott, And also a certaine peece of meadow land containing six acres more or less adjoyning to Joseph Wilson & George Ross on the Great River.

Item I give & bequeath to my Sone Samuell Clarke the other halfe of that land lyeing Neare & adjoyning to John Littlee land the whole containing twentie acres more or less the other half of which I have given to my Sone Richard before mentioned.

Item I give & bequeath to my Sone Samuel Clarke a certaine peece of ground adjoyning to Daniell Ross on the west side & my sone Richard to the Eastward, & on the South to the highway.

Item whereas I gave & bequeathed to my foure Sones (as before is mentioned) Josua Clarke, Ephraime Clarke, Thomas Clarke & Benjamin Clarke, the certaine peece of land Commonly known or called by the Name of the blind Ridge to bee equally shared amongst them foure, my will is now that my Sone Samuell have an equall part of the sayd blinde Ridge, and that the same bee devided into five parts to bee devided amongst my sayd five Sones Josua, Ephraime, Thomas, Benjamin & Samuell share & share alike.

Item I make confirme & appoynt my true & loveing wife Elizabeth Clarke and my Eldest Sone Richard to bee Executrix & executor of this my last Will & Testament, & whereas my Sones Thomas & Benjamin Clarke are both under age In case they should dye or either of them before they arrive to the age of one & twentie years my will & intent is that his or their proportion of the before mentioned Estate be equally devided amongst the

surviveing brothers I doe hereby Ratifie & allow this to bee my last Will and Testament, revokeing & dissannulling all former wills by mee made.

In the name of God Amen I George Harris of Southampton in the East Riding of Yorkshire on Long Island, Yeoman Being in perfect strength of memory, Blessed Almighty God for it Though weak in body and not knowing the appointed tyme of change do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following -

Imprimis - I give and freely bequeath my soul to God my Creator and Redeemer who first gave it to me and my Body I give for decent burial to the earth from whence it was at first taken. and for my worldly estate as is hereafter mentioned -or
Imprimis -

I give and bequeath my house and home lot and all my land in Cow Neck and all the land I have or ever hereafter shall have belonging unto my said house and home lot, within that tract of land commonly called and known by North Sea and my land that fell to me by lott and meadow in ye late Division commonly called the Hog Neck Division to my eldest son George Harris and to his heirs and assigns forever. Provided that if he depart this life without issue then it shall fall unto my second son Henry Harris and to his heirs forever.

I give unto my said son George Harris a fifty pound commonage with all other *** of lands.

2ndly - I give and bequeath unto my son Henry Harris and to his heirs and assigns forever all that my thirty acres of land at Meacocks and all that my late division of land that fell to me by lot in the Scuttle Hole Division and my three eighths of a hundred part commonage with all other *** of land.

3rdly - My will is that notwithstanding all my given Grant of my Land and meadow to my sons that my beloved wife Mary Harris shall have and enjoy all my house and orchard and Barns and meadow my land during her widowhood and after if she shall marry until that my said son George shall be of the age of one and twenty years but in case she never marry again shall to enjoy my house and orchard during her material life and after to return it to my said son George and his heirs.

4thly - I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Harris to be paid her by my Executors within one month next after her marriage twenty pounds of my estate.

5thly - I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Harris to be paid her by my Executors within one month next after her marriage Ten pounds of my estate.

6th - I give and bequeath unto my daughter Janne Harris five pounds on the day of her marriage out of my estate.

WILL OF JOHN JENNINGS
- 1685 -

I, John Jennings, of Southampton, in the County of Suffolk on Long Island, being in perfect strength of memory, blessed be Almighty God for it, - but weak of body and not knowing the day of my death, do make and ordain this my last will and testament, in manner and form following. First I give and freely bequeath my soul to God, my Creator and Redeemer who first gave it to me, and my body after decent burial to the earth from when it was at first taken, and all my worldly goods as it is hereafter inscribed.

Item: I give and bequeath to my eldest son, John Jennings, that land that doth belong to me on the east side of the creek at North Sea, adjacent to land of John Davis and ye close at Cow Neck Gate with ye land adjoining to it lately laid out to me.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son, William Jennings, the lot I bought of Thomas Shaw joining to ye land my house stands on.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son, Samuel Jennings, my house and home lot with all the housings thereon to be possessed by him when he shall be twenty-one years of age, and ye rest of my land, meadows and commonage my will is that it be equally divided between my said three sons, John, William and Samuel and in like manner all my military arms and in case any of my said sons die without issue that estate shall be equally divided to my surviving sons.

It: I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Ann, full and free possession of my house and home lot with all improvements thereon until my son Samuel shall come to ye age of one and twenty years or if she shall live a widow, but in case my said son should die before ye said by me and my wife should marry again, then when my son William shall come of age and whosoever she shall bring into ye said house, shall make ye house and all other buildings when they leave them as they were at there first entering upon them.

Thomas Jessup - Sybil Jennings

AN ANCIENT CONTRACT OF MARRIAGE - 1769.

Whereas there is a contract of marriage between Thomas Jessup of Southampton in the County of Suffolk and Colony of New York, and the widow Sibyl Jennings of the same Town, County and Colony. It is agreed upon between the contracting parties that the said Thomas Jessup is to take into possession the use of and improvement of all her Lands, Meadows, Commonage and Tenements together with the use and improvement of one negro boy called Pompey, and the use of what money she, the said Sibyl Jennings, has and the use of all other movable estate as she, the said Sibyl Jennings is possessed of at the time of her marriage with him the said Thomas Jessup upon the conditions following:

The said Thomas Jessup obliges himself or his heirs or assigns to return (in case she the said widow should survive him) the principal of all such money as he should receive with her and all such household goods or other movable estate as he has by her, also fifty pounds in cash allowing what shall be judged reasonable for the wear of such household goods and also the said Jessup is by this contract or bargain to keep and maintain that little girl called Nehitable, that she the said widow hath now living with her, until said girl arrives at the age of eighteen years; and it is further agreed upon between the contracting parties that the said Sibyl Jennings shall retain in her own self the right to dispose of all such money or movable estate as she shall be possessed at the time of her marriage, to give and dispose of them to whom and where she shall think proper, and also she obliges her self to quit the said Jessup's Estate in case she should survive him, his heirs or Exec. fulfilling the conditions above mentioned, and also the said Jessup is bound to cut no more timber on the Land of the said Sibyl Jennings than eight loads of firewood a year and so much fencing stuff as shall be necessary to maintain the fence around the said farm.
